

This is an Update from the Kings Park Civic Association to all Marvin Drive area residents regarding the Santilli sand mining property.

The Kings Park Civic Association (KPCA) assisted Mr. Santilli in getting the guardrail removed at the end of 5th Avenue so he can add fresh topsoil and rebuild the embankment behind the houses on Marvin Drive. The topsoil will help keep the dust down as well as prepare the area for seeding. Please be advised that the trucks delivering the topsoil will temporarily be going through your area to get to the embankment. A temporary gated fence will be erected until the old fence and guardrail are restored. We thank Councilman Wehrheim and Highway Superintendent Dan Ryan for their assistance in obtaining access to the embankment.

Seeding will probably begin in early September. Trees and bushes may also be added.

The KPCA has also assisted Mr. Santilli in obtaining the required permits to enlarge his water service pipe. This will allow him to refill the water truck quickly so he can manage dust control.
