In response to Mr. Michael Rosato's letter pertaining to Hoyt Farm, please find attached a synopsis of what has transpired to date.

In closing, if I can be of any further assistance in this matter, please feel free to contact me accordingly.

- There have been four (4) reported incidents dating back to May 2006.
- This office continues to be in contact and serve as liaison to the Suffolk County Police Department patrol, COPE and Criminal Control sections concerning these incidents.
- Video surveillance equipment has been set up at Hoyt Farm.
- Increased uniformed Park Ranger patrol presence has been implemented throughout the hours of parks operations.
- Random plain-clothes operations have been and will continue to be utilized.
- Increased park attendant personnel have been put in place to check and verify residency requirements, as well as monitor parking lot activity.
- Department of Public Safety awareness signs have been requested from the Smithtown Parks Department to be installed conspicuously throughout the park.
