

KPCA Membership Votes To Support KP Industrial Area Revitalization Plan

At our August membership meeting, our members voted to support a plan for consistent zoning and revitalization of the Kings Park industrial area. The plan was discussed at two previous KPCA meetings. KPCA representatives corresponded and met with our town, county and state representatives requesting their assistance in revitalizing the area. We believe establishing a consistent zoning policy and master plan for this important part of our hamlet will encourage investment and redevelopment of the area, create jobs, stimulate the local economy and help foster growth in our tax base, possibly lowering our school taxes.

KPCA President Mike Rosato reached out to the Fort Salonga Civic Association, the Kings Park Neighbors Association and the San Remo Civic Association to discuss the plan. Both the Fort Salonga Civic Association and San Remo Civic Association extended invitations to KPCA representatives. Both civic groups seemed open to the idea with San Remo Civic Association President Roy Conforte going so far as immediately sending a letter of support to Town of Smithtown officials.
